STATEMENT CONCERNING ETHICS OF PUBLISHING

- The manuscript has neither been submitted to reviewing, nor is in procedure, or is accepted for publication in any other journal, until the editor in chief/ secretary of the journal notifies the author about the final decision regarding the manuscript.
- The manuscript has not been published before under the same or under any other title in any other scientific journal and, if it is accepted, it will not be published in the same form, or in the same or in any other language.
- The scientific meyhodological regulations concerning quotations from works of other authors and sources are observed.
- The research presented in the work is original and the facts stated are genuine and authentic.
- The authors will transfer copyrights regarding the manuscript to the journal.

The reviewers are requested to adhere to the following principles:

- The manuscript is reviewed impartially and it is evaluated exclusively on the basis of its scientific content regardless of race, gender, origin, religion, citizenship and political preferences of the author.
- The reviewers are anonymous and that implies that the reviewers should not disclose any information regarding the manuscript currently under review.
- The reviewers should relate any relevant information to the editor in chief regarding the manuscript under consideration.

The editorial board is requested to:

 entrust the submitted manuscripts to independent reviewers whose identity is unknown to the authors and to evaluate the manuscripts solely on the basis of its scientific content regardless of gender, race, origin, religious affiliation, citizenship and political preferences of the author.
